## Additional requirements for admission to the Doctoral School at the John Paul II Catholic University of Lublin

In addition to the conditions stipulated in § 1 of the Conditions and Procedure for Recruitment to the Doctoral School at the John Paul II Catholic University of Lublin for the academic year 2024/2025, a candidate should fulfil at least one of the following additional conditions:

- 1. Authorship or co-authorship of a scientific article in a journal that was on the list of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education at the time of publication.
- 2. Authorship or co-authorship of a research monograph or a chapter in a research monograph, or editing of a research monograph published by a publishing house which was on the list of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education at the time of publication.
- 3. Participation in the implementation of projects promoting research, teaching or science.
- 4. Active participation in national or international scientific conferences, including student conferences, or documented activity in the organisation of such conferences.
- 5. Activity in a research club, self-government or another student organisation.
- 6. Participation in the "Diament" programme of the Doctoral School of the John Paul II University of Lublin.
- 7. Rector's award for good academic performance or other forms of student activity.
- 8. A laureate title, distinction or award in a student research competition.
- 9. Scholarship from the Minister of Science and Higher Education or another scholarship for students.
- 10. Participation in international exchange programmes.
- 11. Attainment of a second-cycle diploma or a long-cycle master's degree with distinction.
- 12. Other significant activities, such as voluntary work, charitable work, and activity in social organisations.
